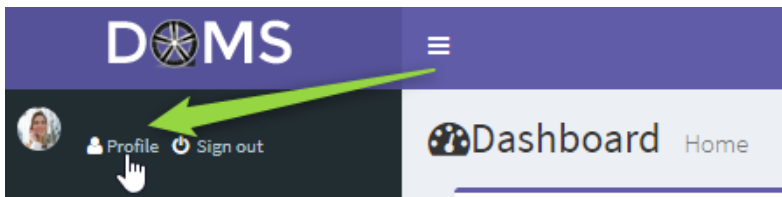


## How to set up Google Authenticator

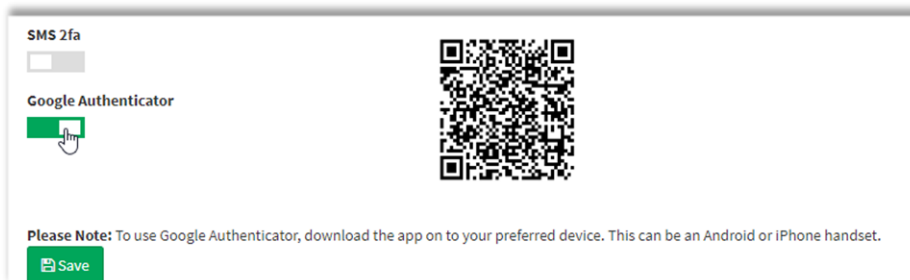
(DQMS v.1.16.6)

In addition to 2-Factor authentication options for SMS, DQMS now caters for Google Authenticator App integration. The option can be selected under the user's profile, or enabled by the administrator with user management access. Please see below on how to enable this.

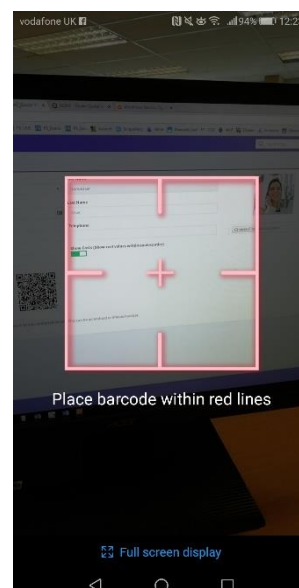
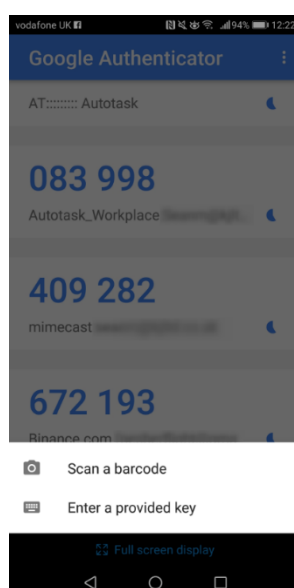
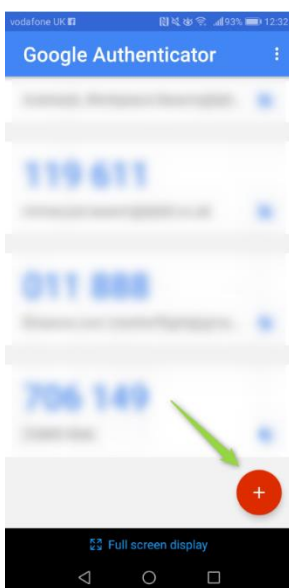
Click on the **burger** icon beside the DQMS logo, then **Profile**



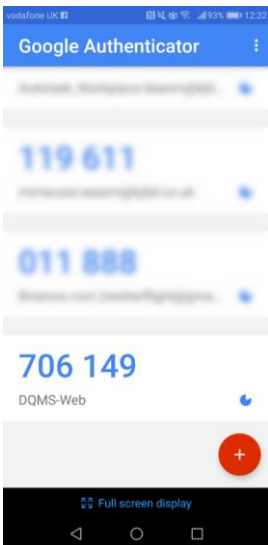
Use the slider to enable Google Authenticator. The next steps will appear below.



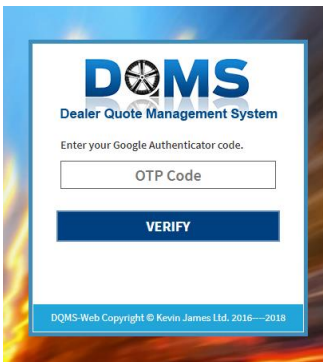
On your mobile device, download the Google Authenticator App. Within the App, press the and select **Scan a barcode** option, and scan the QR Code showing in your profile in DQMS on your computer screen.



The secret is then saved within the App, and listed as **DQMS-Web**.



On DQMS, click the **SAVE** button and sign out. Log into DQMS again and note the OTP Code prompt now present.



Open the Google Authenticator app on your mobile, select the DQMS-Web tile, and type in the One-Time-Password into DQMS
